## Changes to your home



Your home is where a few people with disability live together.



We look after you and your group home now.



In the future, your home will be looked after by a new service provider.



You can stay in your home. You won't have to move.



We want you to keep:

- the same services
- the same support workers

## Why is this happening?



This change is part of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).



The NDIS means that a new service provider will start looking after your home later in 2017.

## Your new service provider



We're glad you could come to our Resident and Family forum today.



You will meet the service provider or providers who we think will do a good job.



We held forums last year where people told us what was important for them in a service provider.



To be sure the service provider or providers will do a good job, we asked them lots of questions and found out lots of information about them.

Government and independent experts checked their answers to the questions.

That's why we think the service provider or providers can do a job.



We want you to ask questions to be sure that:

- You think they will do a good job
- You're certain you will still get all the support you need
